Advanced Rating: \$1,500 to a female pilot to pursue an advanced rating beyond the private pilot's license.

Student Scholarships: Two student scholarships are being offered in the amounts of \$1,500 and \$1,000. Female applicants must have soloed in order to apply for these scholarships.
